# SLOCQHA QUARTER HORSE AWARDS PROGRAM

## 2010

The SLOCQHA year-end award program is designed to allow Quarter Horse exhibitors a program to earn year-end awards by showing at Quarter Horse shows regionally in California.

The following is a summary of the SLOCQHA year-end award program:

1. To be eligible for the SLOCQHA Quarter Horse year-end award program, the owner of the horse and the exhibitor of the horse must be members of (i) Pacific Coast Quarter Horse Association and (ii) the San Luis Obispo County Quarter Horse Association and pay the \$50 Quarter Horse awards fee (per exhibitor, includes all horses shown by that exhibitor).

2. Points for the SLOCQHA awards program will be computed by PCQHA. Any questions should be directed to the SLOCQHA Board of Directors in writing.

3. Points earned at the following California shows will be counted toward the year-end award program:

- a. **Central Valley Saddle Club** -Reedley, CA- March 2010
- b. **Back 2 Basics**- Ranch Murieta-March 2010
- c. **San Luis Obispo County Quarter Horse Association**-Mothers Day Circuit, Paso Robles, CA-May 2010
- d. **Skylark Farms**- Ranch Murieta-June 2010
- e. **Pacific Coast Quarter Horse Association-Summer Celebration**-Watsonville, CA-July 2010
- f. **Santa Clara Valley Quarter Horse Breeders Association**-Watsonville, CA- July 2010
- g. **Pacific Coast Quarter Horse Association-Fall Classic**-Santa Barbara, CA-Sept. 2010
- h. **Quarter Horse Exhibitors Association of California-Wine and Roses Circuit**- Watsonville, CA-October 2010
- i. **Fall Finale** – one day show – Sanger, CA - Oct. 2010
- j. For the Speed Event Year-end Award-all special events held in San Luis Obispo County on and prior to October 31, 2010.
- k. **Trail Special Event** - Templeton, CA – Oct. 10, 2010.

SLOCQHA reserves the right to approve additional shows or special events for the year end awards program provided that the shows are PCQHA approved, Such approvals will be posted on the SLOCQHA web site not less than 90 days before the show or special event.

6. Points will be awarded on the same basis as the PCQHA year-end awards program (See [www.pcqha.com](http://www.pcqha.com)).

7. A horse must win a minimum of 25 points in the applicable category to be eligible for a SLOCQHA Quarter Horse year-end award, except that for High Point Reining, High Point Working Cow Horse and High Point Cutting a horse must win a minimum of 15 points.

8. For all-around awards, a minimum of 5 points must be won in each of three of the eight AQHA approved categories.

9. For high point awards, you are not required to show in all classes shown – just one.
