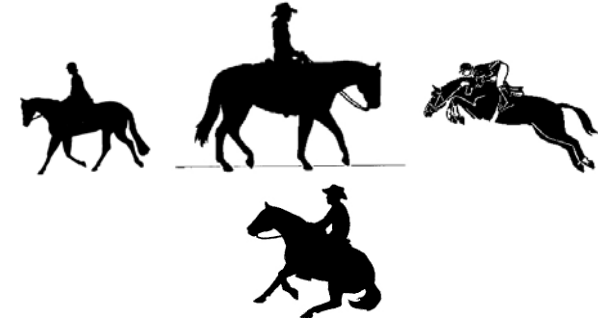

4-H Rules for all 4-H Classes:

4-H class age level categories will be as follows:

Junior – 9-13 years of age as of January 1, 2010

Senior – 14 years of age and not yet 19 years of age of January 1, 2010

Pony – Any equine regardless of breeding 14.2 hands and under with ¼" allowance for

shoes. (All ponies will be measured.)

4-H appropriate dress attire for all horse show classes are as follows:

- Long-sleeve shirt, pants or jeans, ASTM/SEI approved helmet and boots with heels.
- The 4-H uniform is also acceptable if it meets the above minimum requirements
- Silver and/or professional show clothes will not count over good, working equipment
- Advertising of any form on the clothing worn is not permissible
- In the showmanship classes, the ASTM/SEI helmet is not required but is recommended by State 4-H Policy.

SLOCQHA Open Horse Show Buckle Series Eligibility

1. Owner and exhibitor must be a current SLOCQHA Member & pay the additional \$40/member show fee. Award Nomination Fee: \$40 per rider. DUES & AWARD FEES FOR RIDER MUST BE PAID BEFORE ANY SHOW POINTS WILL COUNT FOR YEAR END AWARDS.
2. Must be a current member of SLOCQHA. Memberships are due January 1st of each year:
 - \$25 Individual or business membership
 - \$15 Youth – 18 and under – age as of January 1, 2010
 - \$35 Family membership – family members as defined by AQHA 2010 rulebook.
4. Owner and exhibitor must be primary residents of California
5. A 3- Show Buckle Series is the awards program and points can be checked on our website www.mothersdaycircuit.com
6. Each 1 horse/1 rider or horse shown must compete in 2 of 3 shows and receive a minimum of 10 points to qualify for the year end award. Points for placing. 6,5,4,3,2,1 and if there is less than six, points adjust to number in class. 4 horses 4,3,2,1 etc.
7. Any disputes or need for clarification must be submitted in writing to the board of directors for review at the next board meeting. All decisions made by the board will be Final! The tie breaker is based on the number of first places then second places and etc.
9. All Breeds eligible and welcome.

SLOCQHA Open Horse Show Rules

1. AQHA Rules will apply and the judge's decision is final. All other discrepancies must be submitted in writing to show management and/or committee. Their decision is final.
2. Hard hats with chin straps in place and boots are required in all over-fences classes. Hunt coats optional.
3. Western hats or riding helmets, boots, and long sleeved shirts are required in all western classes. Chaps optional.
4. This is an open show. Schooling in a class is permitted under these guidelines:
 - a. You must wear proper attire, as stated in rules #2 and #3 and display number upside down.
 - b. You must follow the directions of the class and take the gait that is called for by the judge.
 - c. You are not to disrupt the other participants who are competing in the class for an award by your schooling methods. Safety of horses and riders are a priority.
 - d. You may be excused from the class at the judges discretion for not following the above rules.
5. Proper attire required for both halter and showmanship classes.

6. Please make scratches and post entries in the office at least three classes prior. Post entries made at gate will be charged double.
 7. All tack changes must be made near the gate area and please notify management of the changes.
 8. Except for tack changes all people, horses, tack, and other obstacles must be kept clear from the entrance and exit gates of the show arenas.
 9. Warm-Up Trail will be open between 8:00am and 10:45am. No exceptions.
 10. No stallions permitted on grounds.
 11. All children must be under adult supervision at all times.
 12. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
 13. Any horse not properly mannered will be excused from the show grounds.
 14. All cost to replace or repair any damage to the Pat-Mar Ranch grounds and equipment is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
