HY DIMENSIONS TRAIL HORSE AWARD \$500

This perpetual award will go to the "HORSE" with the highest combined placings in AQHA trail classes on Thursday and Saturday. The award is named for Hy Dimensions, a horse whose connections to Paso Robles run deep.

The Hy Dimensions Trail Horse Award will stand at the PCQHA office in Paso Robles. The rider shown on the perpetual trophy is none other than Paso Robles resident, Cynthia Cantleberry.

The winning horse's name will be placed on the trophy each year and the owner of the winning horse will receive a check for **\$500 and bronze medal**. Points will be calculated using the following-if there are 9 or more horses in a class-1st place-9 pts, 2nd place-8 pts, 3rd place-7 pts, etc. If less than 9 horses the point values will go down correspondingly. ***Thank you to Lisa Lazarus, Hy Dimensions owner, for donating the trophy and the winner's check!***

SPECIAL CIRCUIT CHAMPIONSHIP SENIOR HORSE CUTTING

In Memory of Dick Hardy, the San Luis Obispo County Quarter Horse Association is proud to continue a special circuit award for Senior Horse Cutting at the Mother's Day Circuit. The winner will be awarded a bronze trophy donated by the clients of Zanetti Performance Horses. SLOCQHA and the Mother's Day Circuit will also be awarding \$250 to the winner. We would like to thank the gracious clients of Melissa and Ron Zanetti for their generous donation.

Eligibility for All Awards requires that you show to all 4 judges AQHA All Around exhibitors must show in at least 3 AQHA categories per judge, halter to count but is not required.

Circuit Champions will have a choice of awards, including a custom SLOCQHA jacket, in AQHA Classes (\$250 circuit champion classes not included)

\$10 for 1st place and \$5 for 2nd place in ALL CLASSES, Ribbons in all classes!

Lead Line classes: Prizes to each entry.

Please note that all awards must be claimed as soon as possible after your class. No awards will be mailed or otherwise delivered. Awards not claimed at the show will be forfeited.

Points for All Around and Circuit Awards will be calculated on a 9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2, 1 basis. Most number of points in any class is 9. If less than 9 in a class, the points will decrease accordingly. AQHA points will not be added. You must show each day your class is offered for all awards. In case of ties there will be a tie breaker judge. 11 & Under All Breed Walk Jog classes are not AQHA or PCQHA approved. There are no membership or ownership requirements and you can show any breed of horse. Exhibitors may not show in any classes requiring a lope or canter. You may show in AQHA showmanship or halter classes. If you chose to do so, you must meet all AQHA membership and ownership requirements. Amateur and Select Amateur classes could potentially be combined when there are less than 3 entries in either class. This is an AQHA rule. When this happens, the MDC will separate out the points for the Select Amateur awards. Performance Halter Classes are all age classes. To enter these classes your horse must have earned a performance Register of Merit (ROM award in any AQHA division, excluding showmanship. You are required to show proof of your horse's ROM. This can be in the form of a copy of the original certificate or a computer print-out of your horse's performance record. You may NOT show traditional and performance halter with the same horse on the same day in the same division.

Show management reserves the right to adjust class and/or arena schedules, as deemed necessary, for the benefit of our exhibitors. Any changes will be announced in advance. NOTE: You have 30 days from the last day of this show to dispute any charges on your bill or point standings. After 30 days, the books will close.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES !! Please, when your pet leaves a "deposit" be sure to show everyone else the courtesy of cleaning it up NO dogs or horses in the food court area or by Grand Stands!! There is a \$100 penalty for loose dogs and fair management may call for impoundment.

Horse registration papers and AQHA membership cards must be inspected by the show secretary before numbers are issued. NO EXCEPTIONS. Copies are okay. Absolutely NO SIGNED TRANSFERS WILL BE ACCEPTED. If you cannot produce your membership card, you may purchase one at the show. These fees are not refundable by the AQHA.

Class adds & scratches must be done in the office, preferably 2 classes ahead. Exhibitors showing in a class not properly entered may be charged double. "No shows" will be charged the class fee. Gate scratches will not be credited or refunded. There is no charge for adds or scratches made in the office PRIOR to the class. All entries must be accompanied with an open check before numbers are issued. If you worry about mailing an open check, you may give it to us at the show.

Returned Checks must be redeemed with a money order, cashier's check, or cash, including the \$50 penalty, within 10 days of notification or the matter will be turned over to AQHA and/or a collection agency for further action. There will be no re-deposits for any reason. If you have had a check returned at this, or any show where TEEM was the show secretary, please be prepared to pay with cash. This includes stall and RV permit payments. Email entries must be complete and include phone number and address.

Mailed paperwork are official entries and you will be responsible for all fees. You will be billed for same if you are a no show. If you send your entries via FedEx or UPS, use the street address on the entry form. UPS does not deliver on Saturday.

Refunds with a vet or Dr's certificate, only, prior to April 29th. Any refunds will be mailed after the show and are subject to SLOCQHA board approval. In the event the MDC has to get portable stalls, stall refunds will be at the discretion of SLOCQHA. Cattle Fees will apply.

Stalls must be prepaid. No temporary pens are allowed and tying horses to trailers is prohibited. Horses staying overnight on the fairgrounds must be in a stall. No arrivals before 10am, Monday, April 29th. Bedding does not come with stalls. Please order shavings ahead of time by April 23rd. There will be extra shavings and feed available on the grounds during the show. The order form for Premier AG is elsewhere in this premium.

Everyone must adhere to the AQHA dress code when showing. In warm-up arenas you must wear boots while riding. No inhumane tack will be allowed anywhere on the show grounds for the duration of the MDC Circuit. The humane treatment of all animals is expected at all times. The SLOCQHA management reserves the right to eject anyone from the show for unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of an animal. All show premiums, money &/or prizes, will be forfeited if this happens.
